European Trade Union Confederation, 2008

- Preventing stress:
- "...a key point of the approach...remains the preventive aspect...The workplace should be able to provide a healthy environment of health and safety that is psychologically and socially helpful for all workers".
- Recognised that "better dialogue and collaboration between managers and employees or enhanced use of teamwork" can prevent stress and mental health problems at work (p.15)

Prevention is better than cure







ENCHP (2011) identified workplace practices that can prevent stress.











Employers can prevent stress by:

- Improving communication and feedback
- Encouraging and strengthening social support
- Access to further training and qualifications
- Increase control over work autonomy and initiative.
- Reorganise poor work processes
- Include employees in decision making and problem solving
- Balance effort and reward



Our research focused on these strategies.









- Enable employees to cope with frequent and ongoing changes in work practices

- Would the students access further education and training courses.





