Candidates for the above posts in the Academic Department of Anaesthesia and the Department of Anaesthesia at NUI Galway/Galway University Hospitals should be within or have completed General Professional Training. They should have obtained FCAI or other higher qualifications in Anaesthesia and/or Critical Care Medicine

These positions will be based in the Academic Department of Anaesthesia at NUI Galway and the Department of Anaesthesia at Galway University Hospitals.

The Lecturer post holder will have a major involvement in teaching and research and will be responsible for supervising the Perioperative and Critical Care Medicine modules in the third and fifth years of the new curriculum in undergraduate Medicine.

The Clinical Research Fellowships are aimed at senior trainees in Anaesthesia who wish to pursue a major research project leading to the award of a higher research degree, such as PhD or MD. Active areas of basic/translational research include the study of gene and stem cell therapies for ALI/ARDS and myocardial preconditioning. Active clinical research programmes exist in airway device research and in regional anaesthesia.

These positions are for a 12 month period initially, renewable annually for a maximum of 3 years. The commencement date is **July 1<sup>st</sup> 2011**. Interested candidates will be called for interview.
